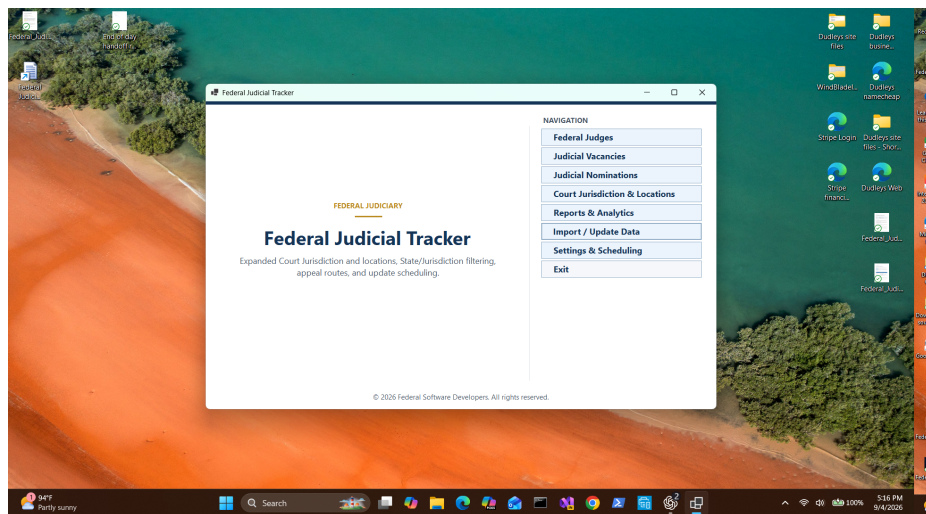

Executive Summary

Federal Judicial Tracker brings frequently consulted federal judiciary information into one organized desktop workspace. Version 1.0.2 helps users move from a question about a judge, vacancy, nomination, court, or jurisdiction to a documented answer with less manual searching across disconnected official pages and files.

The application is designed to complement PACER, court websites, docket platforms, and legal research services. It does not replace those systems and does not provide legal advice, predict outcomes, or determine case assignments.

Why It Matters

- Reduce time spent locating the same federal judicial information across multiple sources.
- Use consistent filters and comparison views when evaluating courts, judges, vacancies, and nominations.
- Preserve a clearer research trail through source links, verification dates, and exportable reports.
- Keep the research workflow on a familiar Windows desktop rather than assembling a patchwork of browser tabs and spreadsheets.

Who It Serves

A Practical Research Workflow

Step	Action	Result
1	Start with a focused question	Choose a judge, court, county, vacancy, nomination, or source category.
2	Narrow the record set	Apply jurisdiction, court, circuit, status, location, and name filters.
3	Review connected context	Move from the selected record to duty stations, associated courthouses, jurisdiction, or appeal route.
4	Verify and document	Open the linked official source, note the verification date, and export a report when the result must be retained or shared.

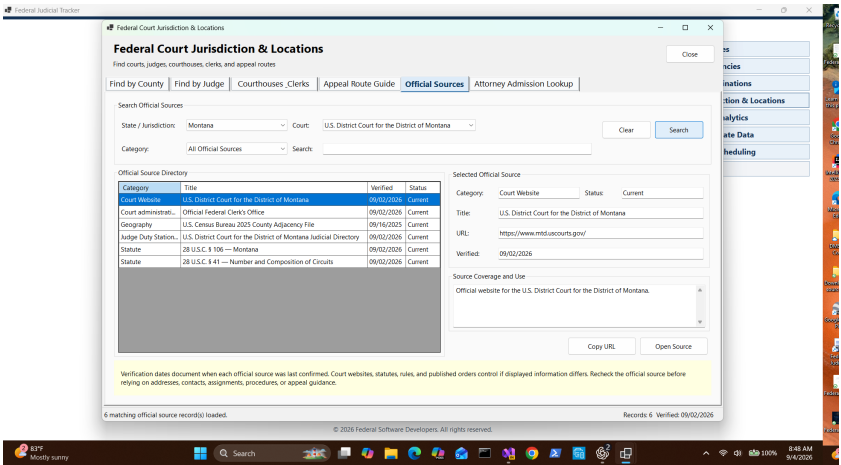

Trust Transparency and Appropriate Use

Federal Judicial Tracker is built around traceability. Records are organized from public, authoritative materials such as federal court websites, the Federal Judicial Center, the Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts, the Senate Judiciary Committee, and governing statutes or published court materials. Source entries include verification information so users can confirm details at the point of use.

Designed for Responsible Research

- Source links remain available for independent confirmation.
- Verification dates distinguish the application's last review from the source's own publication date.
- Geographic coverage describes documented court service and does not establish venue or predict which judge will hear a matter.
- Judicial assignments, duty stations, vacancies, and nomination status can change; users should confirm time-sensitive decisions with the appropriate official source.
- The application provides research support and educational information, not legal advice.

Version 1.0.2 is the current Windows release candidate prepared through a clean installer build and structured validation of core navigation, jurisdiction, judge, courthouse, appeal-route, and official-source workflows.

- Access to the licensed Federal Judicial Tracker application and covered updates during the subscription term.
- A documented installation package and user guidance.
